Special Event: 100th Anniversary of the Opening of the Battlefield Monument

Hamilton, ON – May 2013 – The City of Hamilton invites members of the public to help mark the 100th anniversary of the unveiling of the Battlefield Monument. The 100-foot tall monument was opened in June 1913 on the centennial of the Battle of Stoney Creek, one of the most important events in Canada's history. The monument was erected to commemorate the pivotal battle in the War of 1812 where the British victory was crucial in preventing the Americans from seizing Upper Canada.

The monument was unveiled on June 6th 1913 by Queen Mary in London by transatlantic cable in front of 15,000 attendees including local military forces. It has since become one of Stoney Creek's most recognizable landmarks and a powerful symbol of peace and commemoration.
