

Volunteer Job Descriptions TALL SHIPS® Hamilton

Activities Assistant:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Activities Assistant, you are responsible, confident, and self-motivated individual that is capable of working in a fast paced, team-based environment. Your role is to assist with arts, craft, historical, nautical and all ages activities during the TALL SHIPS® Hamilton event.

"Ask Me" Event Ambassador:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton "Ask Me" Event Ambassador will highlight TALL SHIPS® Hamilton activities to the general public throughout the Hamilton Waterfront location. Your role will include assisting the public with directional and attractions information about Hamilton.

Crowd Control:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Crowd Control volunteer you are responsible for controlling ship lines and assisting patrons on and off the ship. Volunteers are dockside or on the ships assisting with the gangways.

Ticket & Passport Stampers:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Ticket & Passport Stamper you are responsible to ensure that customers have proper ticket/identification to enter ship deck tours and tall ships harbor cruises. You will stamp visit boarding passes with a stamp for each ship.

Relief Volunteer:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Relief Volunteer you will be responsible to provide breaks to volunteers, serves as runner and you may be required to assist other positions.

Hospitality Volunteer:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Hospitality Volunteer you will be responsible to assist with events for ships' crews and trainees.

Transportation Driver:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Transportation Driver you are responsible for the pick up and delivery of items accompanied by the Ship Captains and Crew Members. Your role will require an above average knowledge of Hamilton. Must have a valid Class G license.

Site Crew:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Site Crew you will be responsible for assisting with event set up and take down. Your role will consist of setting up tables, chairs, stage, vendor tents and signage.

Ship Liaison:

As a TALL SHIPS® Hamilton Ship Liaison you are responsible to work directly with the ships throughout their stay in Hamilton. A good working knowledge of Hamilton and how to get around is helpful. Your shifts will occur from Friday June 28 at 12 noon until the morning of Monday July 1, 2013. You will work with a partner and work in shifts over the four days. A typical day includes meeting with the Captain or the First Mate, advising him/her of the days' activities; possibly helping a crew member with personal emergencies, such as finding a dentist, driving the cook to the supermarket for provisioning, etc. Commitment to work entire event is required. All Ship Liaison candidates will be personally interviewed.
