## Over the past decade Hamilton's arts community has

# **The Process**

Community members nominate artists in 1 of 11 categories:

Arts Administration • Arts Education • Community Arts • Fine Craft • Lifetime Achievement • Media Arts • Music • Performance • Theatre • Visual Arts • Writing

Each category, except for Lifetime Achievement, features an Emerging Artist and Established Artist. Nominations are juried by an independent group of arts professionals who keep the results under lockand-key until the night of the awards.

## The Event

## The focus of the event is to showcase and celebrate

the wealth of talent in our community and the achievements of the incredible nominees.

Hosted in 2012 at the Arnie at Mohawk College, the event attracted more than 450 guests. The evening included greetings from our Council and Senior City staff, entertainment by professional and emerging artists from across our diverse community, light refreshments, great networking and anticipation for the awards to be presented.

## The Awards

## Each award recipient is presented with a cash award

and an official certificate of recognition from the City of Hamilton. Additionally, Established and Lifetime Award recipients are given a signature medallion, crafted by Canadian sculptor Dora de Pédery-Hunt, which was originally commissioned by the City in 1976. Mrs. De Pédery-Hunt's work includes the portrait of Queen Elizabeth II that is featured on all Canadian currency.
